#### *Care and Carer Support Agencies*

The Public Trustee and Guardian for the ACT respects, recognises and values carers and care relationships as defined under the *Carers Recognition Act 2021*. The agency works with carers as part of its work across drafting wills and powers of attorney, guardianship, financial management, trust administration and estate administration services.

The agency complies with the *Guardianship and Management of Property Act 1991* as it relates to carers. That is, decision-makers appointed by the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal for either guardianship or financial management must consult with each carer of the protected person for whom the order is made.

The Public Trustee and Guardian is a Territory Authority operating under the Justice and Community Safety Directorate (JACS) umbrella. The internal human resource management policies and resources for employees who are carers described by JACS in its Annual Report also apply to the agency.
